

**OUR TAX REFORMS**

The Internal Revenue Department continues implementing more features to be a modernized tax administration system. During the 2024-2025 financial year, key achievements were as follows:

- As a Multi-Channel Tax Payment Platform, IRD has implemented the Tax Payment Hub Portal to be able to pay tax through Internal Revenue Department's Website. Version 1 of the IRD's Tax Payment Hub was launched on 1-9-2024 and Version 2 was launched on 1-3-2025.
- Starting from 15-10-2024, the 5-Digit Aung Mye Theik Online Lottery System has been launched and the drawing ceremony will be held twice a month with a progressive jackpot prize.
- Starting from 1-11-2024, applications for the Certificate of Exporter/Importer Registration (EIR Card) in the Tradenet 2.0 can only be carried after registration in the IRD's e-Registration Management System. Likewise, starting from 1-1-2025 the renewal process will also be required prior registration in the IRD's e-Registration Management System.
- In the e-Registration Management System, the following processes can be implemented: registration of government departments and individual taxpayer (using only their National Identity Card) and issuance of a non-profit organization taxpayer registration number to taxpayers who change from registered taxpayer status to a non-profit organization taxpayer status.
- To expand the self-assessment system to more taxpayers, 587 corporate taxpayers from MTO-3 and 358 corporate taxpayers from MTO-4 were transferred to the established SAS office, MTO-1.
- The Amendment Act of the Court Fees Act was drafted and enacted by the State Administration Council Law No. (3/2025) dated 17-2-2025.
- In order to raise the public awareness and compliance, one Notification, three Directives, ten Pamphlets, five Publications and one Standard Operation Procedures were published on the Former Ministry of Planning and Finance's Website and IRD's Website.
- Seventeen tax education programs were provided through Tax Education Programs which broadcast on MRTV Radio every Thursday.
- Two Tax Announcements were notified three times in National Newspaper for the public awareness.

**OPERATIONS REVIEW FOR 2024-2025**

**Income Tax** is the main source of tax revenue, accounting for 48 per cent of total collection and collection amounted to 5,156.5 billion kyats in this Fiscal Year.

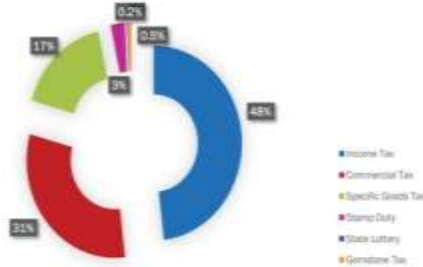
**Commercial Tax and Specific Goods Tax** accounted for 31 per cent and 17 per cent of IRD collection respectively while collections of commercial tax amounted to 3,340.7 billion kyats and Specific Goods Tax amounted to 1,857.6 billion kyats.

**Stamp Duty** on documents amounted to 273.3 billion kyats and accounted for 3 per cent of IRD's collection.

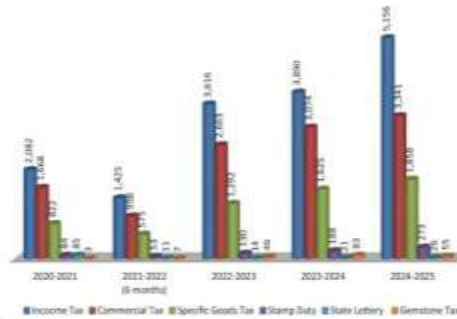
The tax from **State Lottery and Gemstone Tax** collections amounted to 25.6 billion kyats and 54.8 billion kyats respectively, contributing 0.24 per cent and 0.51 per cent of collection in 2024-2025.

Tax Collection by Tax Year (in Kyat Billion)

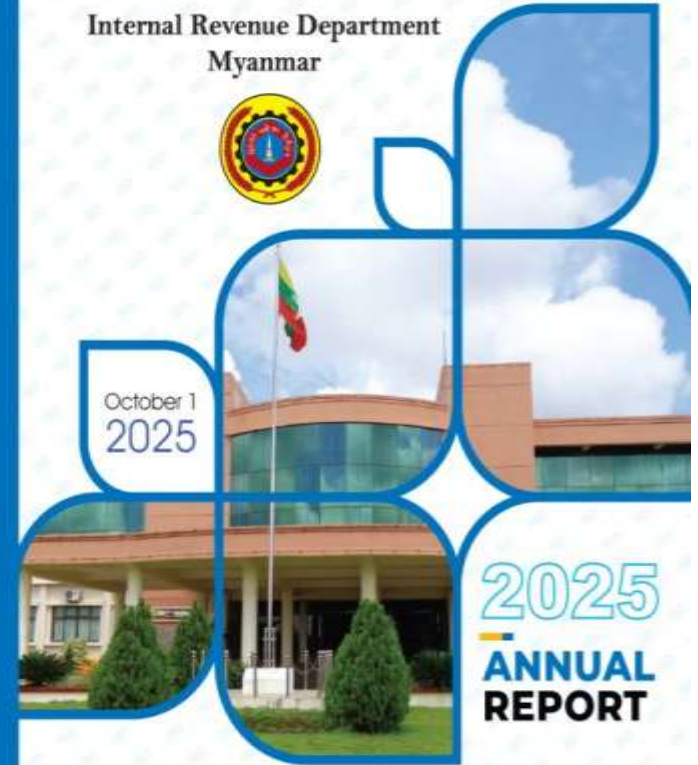

### MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR GENERAL

This report highlights the tax performance of the Internal Revenue Department (IRD) for the period from April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025. During this period, the IRD has continued its efforts to modernize the tax administration system and provide better tax services to taxpayers in respective sectors.

In the tax service sector, IRD has successfully implemented the IRD's Tax Payment Hub Portal, which allows taxpayers to be able to pay their taxes through the IRD website. The 5 Digits Aung Bar Lay Online Lottery System, featuring a Jackpot prize was launched during the 2024-2025 Fiscal year, the public can try their luck in the lottery twice a month via online anytime and anywhere. Through the e-Registration Management System, registration of government departments and individual taxpayers can now apply for a Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) using only their National Registration Card (NRC).

To improve tax collection and enhance taxpayer compliance with the objective of expanding the Self-Assessment System (SAS), 945 medium taxpayers who were previously assessed by the Official Assessment System have been transitioned to the Self-Assessment System.

Moreover, the IRD continues to promote tax knowledge-sharing programs by collaborating with Myanmar Radio and Television (MRTV) for weekly radio broadcasts. It provides timely updates through Myanmar newspapers and the IRD's website.

The IRD expressed its gratitude to all taxpayers for fulfilling their duty by paying taxes, even amidst challenges and difficulties. Particularly due to the Powerful Mandalay earthquake that struck on March 28, 2025, the IRD also faced restrictive damages, nevertheless, IRD would like to appreciate the unity and active support of our staff and taxpayers. Additionally, all the staff of the IRD and the related departments were acknowledged and honored for their collective efforts in ensuring the state received the full and correct amount of tax revenue.

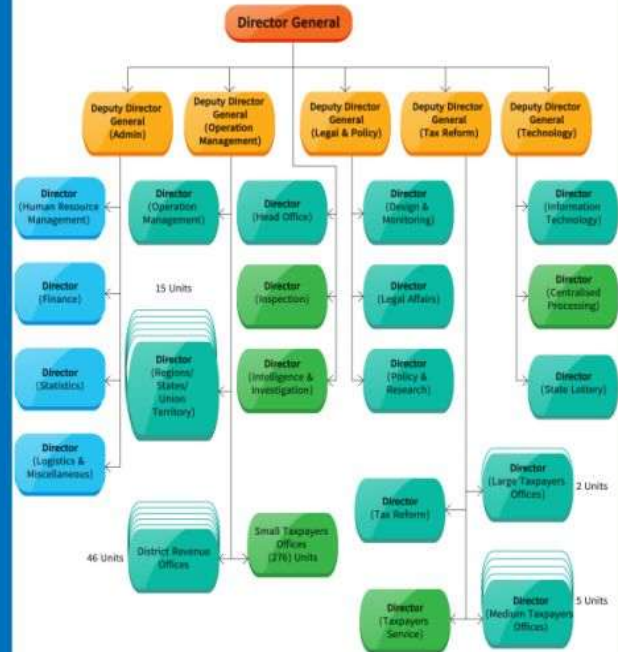
